Should I go to work? Should my child go to school?

- No Symptoms:** Proceed to school/work
 - Exposure with No Symptoms:**
 - NO school or work, contact your doctor
 - Home for 10 days since exposure

Report Exposure at www.LeeSchools.net
 - Diagnosis with No Symptoms:**
 - NO school or work, contact your doctor
 - Home 10 days from 1st positive results

DO NOT go to school or work while waiting for results.
 - Experiencing Symptoms:**
 - NO school or work, contact your doctor
 - Home 10 days from 1st symptoms & 24hrs symptom free without using medication.
 - List of symptoms:** Fever 100.4+, loss of taste or smell, nausea, vomiting, fatigue, diarrhea, muscle or body aches, chills, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, new cough, congestion or runny nose, sore throat, headache.
- Parents, remember if your student is exhibiting any cold-like symptoms, they should stay home and their absence will be excused. We will work together to avoid exposures and illness.**
